What do I need to get into Members Only?

The “Members Only” section of the Timber Pines Computer Club web site is theoretically a second web site with a link from the main site. When you click on the “Members only” button, or icon, the link tells your browser (Internet Explorer, Netscape, etc.) to go to a new location. However our Members Only section is protected by a security program which requires a user name and password before allowing you access to the new site, in this case the “Members Only” section. If you do not allow cookies, or have not set up your computer to allow cookies from timberpinescc.org, then you will not be able to gain access to the “Members Only” section.

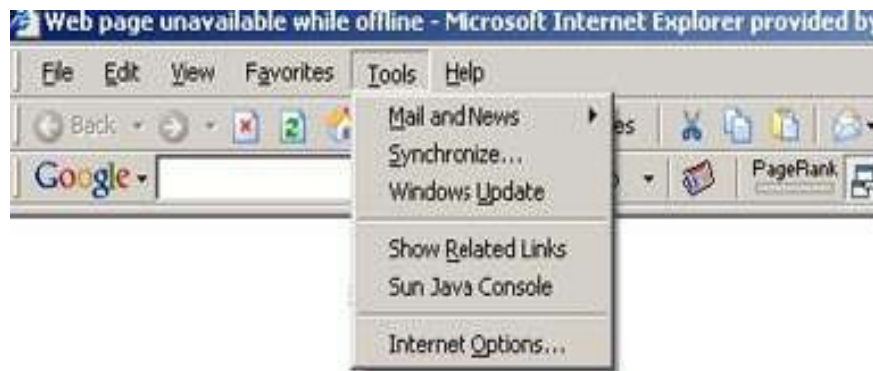
How do I set up my computer to allow cookies from timberpinescc.org ?

1 – Open Internet Explorer, and left click on “Tools”



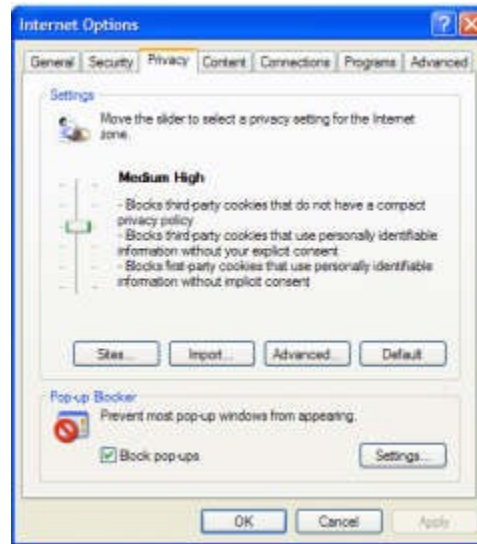
If you are using AOL, or one of the other Internet Service Providers (ISP) that have blocked the “Tools” function from view. You can switch to Microsoft Internet Explorer from your program menu and access the tools option from there.

2 – Now left click on “Internet Options” from the drop down menu.





3 - Left click on the "Privacy" tab. In the lower right of the dialog box, left click on "Edit", or if you have Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher left click on "Sites".





4 - In the box "Address of Web site" type in: www.timberpinescc.org and click on the "Allow" button, followed by the "OK" button. Reboot your computer, then go back and try to access the Members Only Section.
